## Game: Famous Families of the Bible

### Supplies

- “Famous Families of the Bible Game Slides” (see “Additional Resources” folder)
- Sticky notes
- Pens
- Small prizes/candies

### Setup

- Load the game slides in the presenting software of your choice ahead of time.
- Famous Families of the Bible Descriptions and Answers:
  - We were the first two brothers, but we did not have a happy ending.  
Answer: Cain and Abel
  - We were the only family to survive a world-wide flood.  
Answer: Noah and his family
  - We were twin brothers, but the younger brother was tricky and ended up with the oldest brother’s blessing.  
Answer: Jacob and Esau
  - We were married for a long time without being able to have children, but God chose to bless us and the whole world through a baby boy born to us in our old age.  
Answer: Abraham and Sarah
  - We were related through marriage, but when our husbands died, we stuck together and became part of Jesus’ family line.  
Answer: Ruth and Naomi
  - We were brothers who loved fishing together but chose to drop our nets and follow Jesus.  
Answer: Peter and Andrew
  - We were cousins who both had powerful ministries. One of us baptized the other at the start of His earthly ministry.  
Answer: Jesus and John, the Baptist
  - We were sisters who were friends with Jesus, but when He came over to our house, we had different ideas of how to spend our time with Him.

### How to Play

4. Allow the kids to reveal the names they wrote down and put the answer slide up on the screen. If they are correct, give them a small prize or candy.
